## Gospel Lesson: "The Church: a Place of Christ's Love"

Introduction: \_\_\_\_\_\_ is an \_\_\_\_\_\_ characteristic of Christ's Church.

- 1. Loving other \_\_\_\_\_\_ is \_\_\_\_\_ and essential for me as a Christian (13:34-35, 15:12,17).
- 2. \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ other Christians \_\_\_\_\_\_ in Christ's love" (13:34-35, 15:12, 17 and 9-10).
  - a. "Remaining in Christ's love" is \_\_\_\_\_:
    - 1) "Having Jesus \_\_\_\_\_\_ to love me (instead of \_\_\_\_\_\_ to love me)" (Psalm 103:2-4, 10-12, 1 Peter 2:24, and Ephesians 1:7).
    - 2) Communicating that I am in a "He \_\_\_\_\_ me; He loves me \_\_\_\_\_" scenario with God (Hosea 2:19, Ephesians 5:25-32).
  - b. I am saved and \_\_\_\_\_\_ because of the \_\_\_\_\_\_, merciful \_\_\_\_\_\_ of God (16, Ephesians 1:4-5).
  - c. "Christ's love" is \_\_\_\_\_ an aura or spotlight I can step in and \_\_\_\_\_ of through my obedience or disobedience (Psalm 103:2-4, 10-12, 1 Peter 2:24, and Ephesians 1:7).

      - a) So, remain in Christ's love by \_\_\_\_\_ Christ's love to His people—your brothers and sisters in the Church—by \_\_\_\_\_ and saying \_\_\_\_\_ things for/with them.
      - b) And keep the church a place where Christ's love is \_\_\_\_\_\_ and practiced—a place where Christ's love \_\_\_\_\_\_.
- 3. Love with \_\_\_\_\_, as \_\_\_\_\_ defines it (13, 1 Corinthians 13:4-7).
  - a) Jesus' kind of love means sacrificial \_\_\_\_\_\_ and humble \_\_\_\_\_\_ (13, 13:1-17).
  - b) Love is a \_\_\_\_\_ purpose to \_\_\_\_\_ for and \_\_\_\_ actions and \_\_\_\_\_ words of \_\_\_\_\_ toward others; it's not a \_\_\_\_\_ (1 Corinthians 13:4-7).
