**Gospel Lesson: “Jesus is My King (Jesus & the Ark)” (part two)**

Introduction: Christianity, with Jesus, is not a \_\_\_\_\_ from \_\_\_\_\_-Testament religion, but a \_\_\_\_\_ of it.
